***HB 0020 by *Hardaway**

Child Custody and Support - As introduced, establishes the "Office of Noncustodial Parent Advocacy." - Amends TCA Title 36 and Title 37.

***HB 1131 by *Hardaway (SB 1265 by *Bunch)**

Child Custody and Support - As introduced, entitles either party to a visitation agreement to file a petition for an expedited hearing pursuant to the provisions governing expedited hearings for support and reduces period of time for non-compliance with an order of visitation from six months to three months. - Amends TCA Title 36, Chapter 6 and Title 36, Chapter 5.

***HB 1132 by *Hardaway (SB 1266 by *Bunch)**

Child Custody and Support - As introduced, authorizes parent or guardian who pays for supervision of child visitation to select provider of supervision services. - Amends TCA Title 36, Chapter 6.

***HB 2627 by *DeBerry J (SB 2584 by *Black, Ford, O.)**

Children's Services, Dept. of - As introduced, specifies that a court's placement recommendation regarding a child in the custody of the department shall be based on a preponderance of the evidence. - Amends TCA Section 37-1-129.

***HB 2628 by *DeBerry J (SB 2585 by *Black, Ford, O.)**

Children - As introduced, requires a court to find that the department of children's services or licensed child placing agency has made reasonable efforts to place a child for adoption and that it is in the best interest of the child before awarding guardianship to a permanent guardian. - Amends TCA Section 36-1-113.

***HB 2995 by *DeBerry J (SB 3065 by *Woodson, Ketron)**

Uniform Laws - As introduced, enacts the "Uniform Child Abduction Prevention Act." - Amends TCA Title 36.

***HB 2630 by *DeBerry J (SB 2587 by *Black, Ford, O., Gresham)**

Foster Care - As introduced, makes certain changes regarding permanency plans for foster care, including giving parents the right to attend and participate in foster care permanency plan reviews and changing the suggested membership of foster care review boards. - Amends TCA Title 36, Chapter 1 and Title 37, Chapter 2.

***HB 3081 by *Fraley (SB 3017 by *Stewart)**

Children's Services, Dept. of - As introduced, deletes requirement that the department pay for children in state custody based on a county's child population and the average state commitment rate per 1,000 children. - Amends TCA Title 37, Chapter 2.

***HB 2700 by *Dennis (SB 3036 by *Faulk)**

Children - As introduced, creates a rebuttable presumption of substantial harm to a child if the child is not granted visitation with a grandparent who is the parent of the child's deceased parent. - Amends TCA Title 36, Chapter 6, Part 3.

HB 3426 by *Hackworth, Litz (*SB 3004 by *Berke, Barnes)

Adoption - As introduced, clarifies that any spouse of a relative is also a legal relative or related. - Amends TCA Section 36-1-102.

HB 3427 by *Hackworth, Litz (*SB 3002 by *Berke, Barnes)

Support - As introduced, establishes a presumption that each parent has knowledge of a parent's legal and moral obligation to support his or her child or children. - Amends TCA Section 36-1-102.

***HB 2916 by *Bell, Campfield, Hardaway (SB 2881 by *Bunch, Ketron)**

Child Custody and Support - As introduced, states that a court shall order equal parenting time unless the court finds by clear and convincing evidence that a parent is unfit or both parents agree to a parenting plan that does not provide for equal parenting time. - Amends TCA Title 36, Chapter 6, Part 1.

HB 3720 by *Maddox (*SB 3661 by *Finney L)

Juveniles - As introduced, creates a task force to study the statewide replication of Carroll Academy. - Amends TCA Title 37 and Title 49.

***HB 3420 by *Litz (SB 3471 by *Jackson)**

Juvenile Offenders - As introduced, requires an official from the facility or the department of children's services to notify local news media of an escape from a secure detention or correctional facility by a juvenile who is alleged or adjudicated delinquent for an offense that would be a felony if committed by an adult. - Amends TCA Title 37, Chapter 1.

HB 1803 by *West (*SB 1618 by *Beavers)

Domestic Violence - As introduced, requires a court to conduct a needs-based hearing for a criminal offense involving domestic violence in which the alleged abuser is a law enforcement officer or the holder of a valid hunting and fishing license or permit to determine on a case-by-case basis whether to return prior to the disposition of a case any weapons that were seized. - Amends TCA Title 36, Chapter 3, Part 6.

***HB 2674 by *Todd (SB 3615 by *Kelsey)**

Child Custody and Support - As introduced, requires a court to take all monthly expenses of the primary caregiver into account when calculating child support and use the estimated worth of child care when one parent has arranged for free or reduced cost child care. - Amends TCA Title 36, Chapter 5 and Title 36, Chapter 6.

***HB 2443 by *Hardaway (SB 3444 by *Tate)**

Child Custody and Support - As introduced, requires a school or day care official to verify the identity of a person seeking custody of a child before permitting the requested change in the child's custody arrangement at the school or day care center. - Amends TCA Title 36, Chapter 6, Part 1.

***HB 2534 by *West (SB 2535 by *Henry)**

Motor Vehicles - As introduced, authorizes county clerk to perform inspection of salvaged vehicle in order that title may be issued to such motor vehicle. - Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 3, Part 2.

HB 1562 by *West, Gilmore (*SB 0467 by *Harper)

Explosives - As introduced, authorizes local governments to enact more stringent blasting standards than state requirements. - Amends TCA Title 68, Chapter 105, Part 1.

HB 3759 by *West (*SB 3744 by *Bunch)

Insurance, Liability - As introduced, authorizes the commissioner of commerce and insurance to suspend or revoke eligibility of a surplus insurer if the commissioner finds that a surplus insurer is incompetent or not trustworthy and its operations are detrimental to policyholders. - Amends TCA Title 56, Chapter 14, Part 1.

***HB 2686 by *Hill (SB 2691 by *Southerland)**

Education, Higher - As introduced, authorizes graduates of engineering technology programs to sit for fundamentals of engineering (FE) exam. - Amends TCA Title 62, Chapter 2, Part 4.

***HB 2984 by *Mumpower, Sargent, Johnson C (SB 3579 by *Ketrone)**

Insurance Companies, Agents, Brokers, Policies - As introduced, authorizes reimbursement to an insured for services provided by a licensed marital and family therapist. - Amends TCA Section 56-7-2401.

HB 3002 by *McDaniel (*SB 2863 by *Stewart)

Insurance, Health, Accident - As introduced, implements and describes certain coverage limitations and benefits provided by the life and health insurance guaranty association. - Amends TCA Title 56, Chapter 12.

- HB 3654 by *Stewart, Gilmore (*SB 3120 by *Berke, Ketron)**
Environmental Preservation - As introduced, enacts the "Green Jobs Act." - Amends TCA Title 4; Title 49; Title 50 and Title 68.
- HB 3801 by *Armstrong, Turner M (*SB 3834 by *Kyle, Stewart)**
Health Care - As introduced, removes the present law provisions that would repeal the Access Tennessee Act, the Cover Tennessee Act, and the Cover Kids Act on June 30, 2010. - Amends TCA Title 56, Chapter 7, and Title 71, Chapter 3 and 5.
- HB 0843 by *Johnson C (*SB 0286 by *Black)**
Insurance, Life - As introduced, authorizes a charitable organization to pay a commission to a person as a result of charitable gift annuity transaction under specified circumstances. - Amends TCA Title 56, Chapter 52.
- *HB 0128 by *Hardaway (SB 0247 by *Marrero B)**
Real Property - As introduced, requires a seller of real property to provide an energy audit of the property to potential buyers prior to the sale and include such audit in the deed of conveyance. - Amends TCA Title 66, Chapter 5.
- HB 3921 by *Shepard (*SB 3625 by *Burchett)**
Insurance Companies, Agents, Brokers, Policies - As introduced, authorizes the commissioner of health to charge reasonable fees to those persons issuing insurance policies for the failure to make payments for certain drugs with particular indications by the FDA as required by the commissioner. - Amends TCA Section 56-7-2352.
- HB 3641 by *Todd, Jones U (*SB 3277 by *Burchett)**
Fireworks - As introduced, removes the present requirement that the law enforcement officials of the county or municipality must also sign the permits for the public fireworks display along with the fire department. - Amends TCA Section 68-104-211.
- *HB 0148 by *Sargent (SB 0223 by *Stanley, Kelsey, Johnson)**
Commerce and Insurance, Dept. of - As introduced, creates advisory board to commissioner and governor to review complaints against regulatory boards administered by department. - Amends TCA Title 56.
- HB 1415 by *Sargent (*SB 1396 by *Johnson)**
Insurance Companies, Agents, Brokers, Policies - As introduced, removes the requirement that assignment of benefits under an insurance policy apply only to assignments provided after July 1, 1992. - Amends TCA Title 56.

***HB 2794 by *Curtiss (SB 2722 by *Ketron)**

Public Contracts - As introduced, requires information concerning those bidding for masonry contractor work be included on the outside of the envelope containing a bid, in addition to those contractors currently required to be listed. - Amends TCA Section 62-6-119.

***HB 3167 by *Curtiss (SB 3608 by *Ketron)**

Explosives - As introduced, requires blasters to file a notice with commerce and insurance prior to the blast occurring. - Amends TCA Section 68-105-103.

Contractors - As introduced, specifies the manner in which notices and answers required or authorized to be made or filed with the board of licensing contracts may be served. - Amends TCA Title 62, Chapter 6.

***HB 2727 by *Campfield (SB 3757 by *Bunch)**

Telecommunications - As introduced, requires telephone companies under jurisdiction of TRA to provide call blocking services for telephones, including cellular phones; encourages cooperatives and foreign corporations furnishing telephone service in this state to offer services for persons to block unwanted calls. - Amends TCA Title 65.

***HB 3395 by *Rich (SB 3913 by *Norris)**

Short Term Loans and Lenders - As introduced, extends hours when pawnshops can be open from "8:00 am to 6:00 pm" to "8:00 am to 9:00 pm." - Amends TCA Section 45-6-212.

HB 3706 by *Towns, Turner M (*SB 3368 by *Marrero B)

Banks and Financial Institutions - As introduced, requires each institution regulated by the commissioner to have a written explanation that clearly explains to the customer information concerning any fee assessed by the institution and to provide instructions for employees to clearly explain the fee information if the customer requires further explanation. - Amends TCA Title 45, Chapter 1, Part 1.

***HB 3707 by *Towns**

Banks and Financial Institutions - As introduced, limits the amount of the handling charge assessed to not more than the amount of the check, draft, or order if such instrument is less than \$30.00. - Amends TCA Section 47-29-102.

HB 3824 by *Stewart, Coleman (*SB 3841 by *Kyle, Haynes)

Securities - As introduced, defines "investment-related" under the Tennessee Securities Act; authorizes a civil penalty for violations of Act; revises other various provisions of Act. - Amends TCA Title 48, Chapter 2, Part 1.

Private Protective Services - As introduced, requires licensure of proprietary security organizations. - Amends TCA Title 62, Chapter 35, Part 1.

***HB 3632 by *Todd (SB 3467 by *Stewart)**

Boards and Commissions - As introduced, revises persons exempt from licensure as an alarms system contractor. - Amends TCA Title 62, Chapter 32.

***HB 2494 by *Hardaway (SB 3242 by *Tate)**

Professions and Occupations - As introduced, enhances penalty for persons who engage in or offer to engage in locksmithing services without a license. - Amends TCA Title 62, Chapter 11.

***HB 0024 by *Hardaway (SB 1343 by *Tate)**

Law Enforcement - As introduced, requires local law enforcement to begin an investigation within 12 hours of receiving a report of an alleged violation by a funeral director of abuse of a corpse or concerning the handling, custody, care, or transportation of dead human bodies. - Amends TCA Section 39-17-312 and Title 62, Chapter 5.

***HB 0041 by *Hardaway (SB 1342 by *Tate)**

Funeral Directors and Embalmers - As introduced, requires a funeral establishment to store or make arrangements to store in a cold storage vault a dead human body received by the funeral establishment for burial until shortly before the funeral service and burial of the body is scheduled to occur. - Amends TCA Title 62, Chapter 5.

Game and Fish Laws - As introduced, specifies that hunting or taking animals by use of bait shall not be prohibited unless the bait is visible at the time and location of such hunt or taking. - Amends TCA Title 70, Chapter 4, Part 1.

HB 2839 by *Floyd (*SB 2400 by *Watson)

Alcoholic Offenses - As introduced, increases the penalty for the offense of boating under the influence of an intoxicant to approximate DUI penalties. - Amends TCA Title 39; Title 55 and Title 69.

Consumer Protection - As introduced, prohibits the installing of covered file-sharing programs on a computer without providing clear and conspicuous notice to the owner that files will be publicly available; establishes that such practices violate the Tennessee Consumer Protection Act. - Amends TCA Title 47, Chapter 18, Part 1.

***HB 3421 by *Litz (SB 3518 by *Overbey)**

Unemployment Compensation - As introduced, requires the weekly benefit amount to be paid by electronic transfer to a specific bank account if requested by the claimant; revises certain amounts concerning benefits paid by check. - Amends TCA Title 50, Chapter 7.

HB 3889 by *Harrison (*SB 2409 by *Faulk)

Unemployment Compensation - As introduced, excludes periods of temporary total disability under the workers compensation law from calculation of base period for purposes of unemployment compensation. - Amends TCA Title 50, Chapter 6 and Title 50, Chapter 7.

HB 3299 by *McCormick (*SB 2977 by *Berke)

Insurance Companies, Agents, Brokers, Policies - As introduced, permits association captive insurance companies to insure obligations under certain federal legislation that provides compensation and benefits to workers for job-related injuries, and further allows association captive insurance companies to hold any interest in qualified headquarters property. - Amends TCA Title 50 and Title 56.

***HB 2897 by *Armstrong, Hill, Tindell, Campfield, Rich, Favors, Odom, Fitzhugh, Winningham, Harwell, Montgomery, Richardson, Camper, DeBerry L, Swafford, Williams (SB 3062 by *Woodson)**

Education, Higher - As introduced, requires institutions of higher education within the University of Tennessee and the Tennessee Board of Regents systems to accept courses completed within 20 years for transfer, credit, graduation, or matriculation; excludes science, technology, and medical courses. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 7, Part 1.

HB 3074 by *Hill (*SB 2885 by *Crowe)

Tennessee Higher Education Commission - As introduced, requires THEC to periodically review the reduction in force policies in effect in public institutions of higher learning and make recommendations to the governing boards the of the University of Tennessee and the state university and community college systems and the house and senate education committees. - Amends TCA Title 8 and Title 49.

HB 3479 by *Matlock, Montgomery (*SB 2899 by *McNally)

Lottery, Scholarships and Programs - As introduced, redefines "eligible independent postsecondary institution" to include institutions that are members of an accrediting agency that is recognized by the U.S. department of education and the Council on Higher Education Accreditation. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 4, Part 9.

***HB 2721 by *Campfield (SB 3773 by *Bunch)**

Lottery, Scholarships and Programs - As introduced, permits students majoring in math, nursing, or engineering or enrolled in a teacher education program seeking licensure to teach math or science to retain the Tennessee HOPE scholarship by making a cumulative collegiate grade point average of 2.75 whenever academic eligibility is checked. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 4, Part 9.

HB 3242 by *McCord (*SB 2815 by *Overbey)

Lottery, Scholarships and Programs - As introduced, allows HOPE eligible student, under certain circumstances, to regain a HOPE scholarship lost by leaving an eligible two- or four-year postsecondary institution, where the student had a HOPE scholarship, and enrolling at a Tennessee technology center, if the student subsequently returns to an eligible two- or four-year institution. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 4, Part 9.

***HB 0043 by *Hardaway (SB 0898 by *Burks)**

Lottery, Scholarships and Programs - As introduced, divides lottery scholarship ASPIRE award into a grant and a required work-study program. - Amends TCA Section 49-4-915.

***HB 0058 by *Hardaway (SB 0892 by *Burks)**

Lottery, Scholarships and Programs - As introduced, permits Tennessee HOPE scholarship recipient to maintain academic eligibility by maintaining good standing at the eligible postsecondary institution in which the student is enrolled; changes initial eligibility requirements for certain students to conform to the change in the continuing eligibility requirement. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 4, Part 9.

***HB 3109 by *Jones S (SB 3106 by *Marrero B)**

Teachers, Principals and School Personnel - As introduced, requires a teacher be paid for supervision of extracurricular activities at an hourly rate equivalent to the teacher's salary. - Amends TCA Title 49.

***HB 3411 by *Brown (SB 3276 by *Burks)**

Local Education Agency - As introduced, urges LEAs to consider the needs of working parents in scheduling parent-teacher meetings. - Amends TCA Title 49.

HB 3028 by *Brooks H (*SB 2783 by *Burchett)

Education - As introduced, requires TSSAA to have member schools perform background checks on applicants for coaching or coaching assistant positions, including volunteer positions, before having contact with students. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 5 and Title 49, Chapter 6.

***HB 3336 by *Carr (SB 3438 by *Tracy, Ketron)**

Juveniles - As introduced, increases the fine a judge may assess against the parent of a child adjudicated unruly for truancy from \$50.00 to \$100 and the number of hours of community service from five to 10. - Amends TCA Title 37 and Title 49.

HB 3874 by *Jones U (*SB 3246 by *Tate)

Criminal Offenses - As introduced, authorizes prosecutors to allow guardians of children violating truancy laws to attend parent education training and parent-teacher conferences as an alternative to criminal prosecution. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 6, Part 30.

HB 3546 by *Maddox (*SB 2819 by *Finney L)

Teachers, Principals and School Personnel - As introduced, requires director of schools to submit salary ratings to the commissioner of education by November 1 rather than December 1 of the school year for which the personnel are elected. - Amends TCA Title 49.

HB 3866 by *Shaw (*SB 3292 by *Burks, Yager)

Buses - As introduced, removes length of service limitations and increases maximum mileage from 200,000 to 250,000 allowed for operation of school buses by LEAs. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 6, Part 21.

HB 3450 by *McDonald, Pitts (*SB 3206 by *Finney L)

Salaries and Benefits - As introduced, authorizes leave to visit a sibling deployed for military duty out of the country. - Amends TCA Title 49.

***HB 3494 by *Brooks K, Harrison, Ferguson, Williams, Bone, Curtiss, Rich, Weaver, Matlock, Floyd, Carr, Cobb J, Fincher, Evans (SB 3397 by *Burks, Faulk)**

Public Health - As introduced, honors the memory of the late Connie Hall Givens by renaming, in her honor, the Coordinated School Health Improvement Act. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 1, Part 10.

HB 0874 by *Bell (*SB 0421 by *Bunch)

Education - As introduced, allows the sale of 12 ounce products in middle schools. - Amends TCA Section 49-6-2307.

***HB 2513 by *Pitts (SB 2567 by *Barnes)**

Schools, Private - As introduced, requires non-public schools to provide parents with information on meningococcal disease and its prevention at the beginning of every calendar year. - Amends TCA Title 49.

HB 3200 by *Winningham (*SB 2621 by *Tracy, Ketron)

Students - As introduced, authorizes random drug testing of students who participate in extracurricular activities; requires LEAs testing students for drugs to have policies and procedures for assisting and counseling students testing positive. - Amends TCA Section 49-6-4213.

Equalization Board - As introduced, places restrictions on appointments to the assessment appeals commission; requires a member to recuse himself from voting on an issue before the assessment appeals commission in certain circumstances. - Amends TCA Section 67-5-1502.

State Government - As introduced, requires all contracts for goods or services being purchased that are entered into between the state or a county and an LLC include a requirement that the LLC shall disclose the name of each partner before the contract becomes effective; such disclosure to be posted on the state's or county's web site, as applicable, with sufficient information to identify the respective contract. - Amends TCA Title 5, Chapter 1, Part 1 and Title 12, Chapter 4.

***HB 3510 by *Niceley, Casada (SB 3677 by *Burchett)**

Congress - As introduced, creates joint congressional communications committee of general assembly; authorizes changing of congressional districts between apportionment. - Amends TCA Title 2 and Title 3.

HB 3911 by *Rich (*SB 3435 by *Tracy, Ketron, Crowe)

Highway Patrol - As introduced, authorizes a highway patrol member that retires involuntarily after 20 years of honorable service to keep his badge and weapon and to receive a retired commissioned card. - Amends TCA Section 4-7-110.

***HB 2722 by *Campfield (SB 3761 by *Bunch)**

Education - As introduced, authorizes LEAs to accept refurbished computer equipment for distribution to low income students. - Amends TCA Title 41, Chapter 22, Part 1 and Title 49, Chapter 6, Part 20.

***HJR 0744 by *Lynn, Maggart, Rich, Weaver, Dennis, Eldridge, Hensley, White, Swafford**

General Assembly, Statement of Intent or Position - Expresses Tennessee's continued support for the State of Israel. -

HB 3364 by *Gilmore, Shepard (*SB 3112 by *Marrero B)

Solid Waste Disposal - As introduced, requires the solid waste disposal control board and department of environment and conservation to demonstrate specific compliance with Public Chapter 462 of 2007 before taking any action concerning solid waste regulation. - Amends TCA Title 68, Chapter 211.

***HB 3429 by *McDonald, Ramsey, Bone, Swafford, DeBerry J, Niceley, Stewart, Kernell, Coley, Turner M, Richardson, Jones S, Shepard, West (SB 3469 by *Jackson, McNally, Marrero B)**

Recycling - As introduced, enacts the "Tennessee Beverage Container Recycling Act," whereby certain procedures, processes, and fees are described for the recycling of such waste. - Amends TCA Title 68, Chapter 211 and Chapter 86.

HB 3847 by *Turner M (*SB 3847 by *Kyle, Berke)

State Government - As introduced, enacts the "Tennessee Residence Commission Act of 2010." - Amends TCA Title 4, Chapter 23.

HB 2974 by *Shaw (*SB 2738 by *Faulk)

Open Meetings - As introduced, authorizes Internet posting on municipal web sites to be adequate public notice if the municipality has an Internet notice posting policy that contains provisions designed to educate residents on the availability of Internet notices and instructions on how to access Internet notices. - Amends TCA Title 8, Chapter 44.

***HB 3347 by *Curtiss (SB 3556 by *Ketron)**

Comptroller, State - As introduced, directs the comptroller to review statutory financing available to local governments and make suggestions that would improve the credit ratings, reduce bond insurance costs, and improve the sale of securities by local governments; requires that comptroller file report with appropriate committees of general assembly by March 1, 2011. - Amends TCA Title 4; Title 7; Title 8; Title 9; Title 10; Title 12 and Title 49.

HB 2911 by *Gilmore (*SB 2801 by *Marrero B)

Atomic Energy and Nuclear Material - As introduced, requires any permit issued by the department of environment and conservation to specify the types of waste a facility is prohibited from receiving for disposal or processing; prohibits any person from knowingly accepting for disposal or processing certain nuclear or radioactive materials in any landfill. - Amends TCA Title 68.

HB 3252 by *Armstrong, Tindell, Niceley, Dunn, Brooks H, Haynes, Campfield (*SB 2785 by *Burchett, Ketron)

Veterans - As introduced, grants special consideration for veteran owned businesses, similar to the consideration given to women owned businesses, in the awarding and procuring of state contracts. - Amends TCA Title 12, Chapter 3, Part 8.

HB 0262 by *Watson, Rich, Shipley (*SB 0063 by *Bunch)

Driver Licenses - As introduced, requires that all written examinations for driver license or intermediate driver license be in English. - Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 50, Part 3.

***HB 3361 by *Campfield (SB 3780 by *Bunch)**

Special License Plates - As introduced, authorizes issuance of Catholic Charities new specialty earmarked license plates; allocates 50 percent of funds produced from sale thereof to Catholic Charities of East Tennessee. - Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 4.

HB 2797 by *McCord, Watson, Dean, Brooks K, Haynes, Yokley, Bell, Hawk (*SB 2704 by *Southerland)

Motor Vehicles - As introduced, requires inspections of vehicles used for commercial whitewater and recreational river use to be at non-peak seasonal times; authorizes such vehicles to haul trailers. - Amends TCA Title 55 and Title 65, Chapter 15.

HB 3791 by *Pitts, Turner M (*SB 3907 by *Kyle, Jackson)

Traffic Safety - As introduced, clarifies and adds to types of information that must be included in traffic citations and abstracts of court records pertaining to traffic violations; requires persons holding commercial driver licenses to have a medical card or provide evidence of exemption beginning January 1, 2011, makes other changes concerning motor vehicles. - Amends TCA Title 55.

***HB 2544 by *Brooks K, Casada (SB 2523 by *Johnson)**

Traffic Safety - As introduced, creates offense of super speeding when driver speeds at 75 mph or more on any two-lane highway or 85 mph or more on any public highway; violation is a Class B misdemeanor punishable by a \$200 fine only. - Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 10, Part 2 and Title 55, Chapter 8.

***HB 3120 by *Gilmore (SB 3222 by *Harper, Black)**

Driver Licenses - As introduced, requires circuit court and criminal court clerks to establish driver license recovery plan for certain persons with suspended driver licenses. - Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 12, Part 1 and Title 55, Chapter 50, Part 5.

***HB 3079 by *Shipley (SB 3028 by *Faulk)**

Highways, Roads and Bridges - As introduced, authorizes certain all-terrain vehicles to be registered and operated on certain municipality or county highways, at discretion of such local governing body. - Amends TCA Title 55.

HB 3267 by *Harmon (*SB 3044 by *Tracy)

Traffic Safety - As introduced, clarifies that municipalities may by ordinance adopt all provisions of law included in the rules of the road for local enforcement. - Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 10, Part 3.

***HB 0036 by *Hardaway (SB 1350 by *Tate)**

Motor Vehicles - As introduced, removes present exemptions to offense involving allowing minor on off-highway vehicle without helmet. - Amends TCA Section 55-52-201.

***HB 3371 by *Haynes (SB 3287 by *Burchett)**

Traffic Safety - As introduced, prohibits traffic citations for failure to stop completely before turning right at an intersection based solely on evidence from surveillance cameras. - Amends TCA Section 55-8-198.
