FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 26 – HB 1128

March 6, 2009

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (004001): Requires designating signs to be erected only if non-state funds are paid to the Department of Transportation to manufacture and erect such signs.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Increase State Expenditures - \$325/One-Time/Highway Fund

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Other Fiscal Impact – Minimal to State and Local Government – However, to the extent that non-state funds are received from a local government, there will be a one-time, permissive increase in local government expenditures of \$325.

Assumption applied to amendment:

- The cost to manufacture and erect two signs @ \$162.50 each is \$325.
