HB 1840 – SB 2105

March 12, 2009

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (004898): Adds Shelby County to the original bill. Authorizes the register of deeds to redact Social Security numbers maintained on computers or removable computer storage media.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Increase Local Expenditures - \$360,000/One-Time/Permissive

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:
