SB 619 – HB 920

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (005425): Deletes the language of the original bill. Requires all license plates which are created after the effective date of this bill to include the language www.tnvacation.com to promote the state's official travel planning Web site.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Increase State Expenditures - \$350,000/One-Time

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumptions applied to amendment:

- According to the Department of Revenue, new metal plates are due to be created in 2011 or 2012.
- The Web site could be added at this time.
- Any cost to add the Web site in the new design is estimated to be not significant.
