FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 360 – SB 1271

March 27, 2009

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (005239): Deletes the language “restricted driver license” in the first sentence of Section 1 of the original bill, and replaces it with “restricted driver license after such person’s driver license has been suspended for ninety (90) days”.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Increase State Revenue - \$14,800
Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Increase Local Expenditures – Not Significant

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Increase State Revenue - \$14,800
Increase State Expenditures – \$3,500/One-Time

Increase Local Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumptions applied to amendment:

- Based on information provided by the Department of Safety (DOS), any change to revenue estimated for the original bill would be minimal because the same individuals are still expected to request restricted driver licenses.
- According to DOS, the department would need to make a modification to one departmental computer application. The one-time state expenditures for this modification is estimated to be \$3,500.
- No change to local government expenditures as a result of this bill as amended.
