**FISCAL MEMORANDUM**

**HB 219 – SB 1788**

April 24, 2009

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (006852):** Requires the Bureau of TennCare to notify each member of the General Assembly prior to any proposed amendments or renewals of the federal waiver and regularly report on the status of reforms and improvements, number of recipients and cost to the state, viability of the managed care organizations and providers in the program, success of fraud detection and prevention, conducted actuarial studies, budget proposals, managed care programs, and long-term care programs, functions, and activities.

**FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:**

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

**FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:**

**Unchanged from the original fiscal note.**

Assumptions applied to amendment:

- The Bureau of TennCare will not incur a significant increase in expenditures to notify all members of the General Assembly prior to renewing or amending the federal waiver or reporting on the required information.
- Any cost can be accommodated within existing resources without an increased appropriation or reduced reversion.
