HB 1383 – SB 1650

April 28, 2009

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (007043): Deletes all language after the enacting clause and requires the Select Committee on Children and Youth to study the effectiveness of the child protective services system and develop recommendations for its improvement.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Increase State Expenditures - \$102,300/One-Time
\$3,511,700/Recurring

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumptions applied to amendment:

- The Select Committee on Children and Youth will perform the required study during its regularly scheduled meetings.
- Any cost can be accommodated within existing resources without an increased appropriation or reduced reversion.
