FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 1256 – SB 1528

May 8, 2009

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (005489): Deletes the language of the original bill. Creates an “In God We Trust” new specialty earmarked license plate. Funds from the sale of such plates shall be allocated to the Tennessee State Museum Foundation, Inc., pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 55-4-215.
