FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 1001 – SB 1007

May 11, 2009

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENTS (007343, 007318): Extends the termination date of the Elevator and Amusement Device Safety Board until June 30, 2010, adds one new member to the Board, and requires the Board to appear before the General Assembly. Under the *Tennessee Governmental Entity Review Law*, the Board is scheduled to terminate on June 30, 2009.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENTS:

Increase State Expenditures – \$1,500

Assumptions applied to amendments:

- This bill continues an existing entity at its current funding level.
- Requiring the Board to appear before the General Assembly will have a not significant impact on state government.
- According to the Department of Labor and Workforce Development, the Board has four regularly scheduled board meetings and one special meeting per year.
- Members shall serve without receiving compensation for their services.
- Adding one new member to the Board will increase state expenditures by \$1,500 for hotel, mileage, and meal allowances.
