FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 2018 – SB 2168

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (008702): Revives the language of Tenn. Code Ann. §17-1-301 as it existed on June 30, 1999, if the Judicial Selection Commission ceases to exist on June 30, 2009, due to the expiration of the Commission's wind-up period, and if, prior to the expiration of the wind-up period, no other legislation is enacted to abolish or replace the Commission or transfer its duties to another entity.

CORRECTED FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant
