FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 2416 – HB 3130

February 19, 2010

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (014363):** Deletes all language after the enacting clause of the original bill. Places a specific code of ethics for all K-12 public education teachers into the law. Includes violation of this code of ethics under the current definition of what conduct unbecoming a member of the teaching profession may consist of. Deletes language that includes violation of the code of ethics of the Tennessee Education Association (TEA) under the current definition of what conduct unbecoming a member of the teaching profession may consist of.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Increase State Expenditures - \$6,000/One-Time

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

MINIMAL

Assumption applied to amendment:

- Placing a specific code of ethics in the law, instead of using one written by the TEA, will have no fiscal impact on state or local government.
