FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 3866 – HB 3833

March 22, 2010

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (015559):** Authorizes the Emergency Medical Services Board to discipline or deny authorization to any person regulated by the Board who violates any criminal statute of any state within the United States or a Canadian province.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Increase State Revenue – Not Significant  
Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

**Unchanged from the original fiscal note.**

Assumptions applied to amendment:

- Any rulemaking necessary will be accomplished during a regularly scheduled meeting of the Emergency Medical Services Board. Any cost can be accommodated within existing resources.
- The amendment does not change the removal of the limitation of \$25 for any reinstatement fees issued to an applicant whose certification has expired. Any increase to fee revenue due to reinstatement fees not being limited to \$25 will not be significant.
