FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 3061 – HB 3936

March 23, 2010

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (015793): Deletes the original language of the bill. Establishes a seven-member Tennessee Wildlife Resources Advisory Committee to review and comment on legislation that would affect the Wildlife Resources Commission. Members will meet no more than two times per year. The Speakers of each Chamber will appoint two members and three members will be appointed by the Chairman of the Wildlife Resources Commission. The advisory committee will be abolished on July 1, 2012.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Increase State Expenditures - \$2,800/Wildlife Resource Fund

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Increase State Expenditures – \$1,800/Wildlife Resource Fund/FY11-FY12

Assumption applied to amendment:

- Seven members will require travel reimbursement for two meetings per year with an average of 286 miles traveled per member per meeting. Mileage is reimbursed at \$0.45 per mile resulting in an increase to state expenditures of \$1,801.80 (7 members x \$0.45 x 286 miles x 2 meetings).
