FISCAL MEMORANDUM**

HB 3379 – SB 3367

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (016218): Deletes Section (1)(c) from the original bill and adds language authorizing the destruction of an animal that has been seized or found abandoned by an agent or officer of a humane society.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Increase Local Expenditures – Not Significant

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

On April 15, 2010, we issued a fiscal memorandum that stated the impact was *unchanged from the original fiscal note*. The original fiscal note reflected in this fiscal memorandum stated a not significant increase in state expenditures. Upon further review, it was discovered that the original fiscal note reflected a not significant increase in local expenditures. The error has been corrected and there is no change in the fiscal impact of the memorandum.

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption applied to amendment:

- Including the authorization for legal destruction of animals that have been seized by agents or officers of a humane society will have no additional impact on state or local government.
