FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 401 – HB 1338

April 20, 2010

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (017141): States that it is the intent of the General Assembly to name an appropriate interchange, bridge or bridges on State Route 840 (Tennessee National Guard Parkway) as the *CW2 Billie Jean Grinder Memorial Bridge (or Interchange)*, the *Sergeant David Clay Prescott, Jr. Bridge (or Interchange)*, the *Captain Marcus Ray Alford Memorial Bridge*, and the *Staff Sergeant Michael Wayne Tinsley, Sr. Memorial Bridge* and directs the Department of Transportation to manufacture and erect suitable signs. Any segment or structure named on State Route 840 (Tennessee National Guard Parkway) shall be dedicated as a memorial to a fallen Tennessee National Guardsman. The final decision in selecting the appropriate interchange, bridge or bridges shall be made in consultation with the representative and senator representing the district in which these individuals resided.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$1,300/One-Time/Highway Fund

Assumptions applied to amendment:

- This estimate assumes four bridges or interchanges will be named, one for each honoree.
- The cost to manufacture and erect eight (8) signs @\$162.50 each is \$1,300.
