SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the court clerk to give the debtor an itemized statement of all costs, taxes, and fees, provide receipts when debts are paid, and indicate when the debt has been paid in full.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase Local Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- Local governments may experience a not significant increase in expenditures for providing statements to debtors.
- The majority of clerks currently provide these statements at the debtor's request.
