FISCAL NOTE

HB 1165 - SB 1269

February 25, 2009

SUMMARY OF BILL: Directs the Department of Transportation to erect and maintain directional signs that inform citizens of the most direct route to Bachman Academy on I-75 eastbound and westbound near exit 20. Directional signs shall be erected only if non-state funds are paid to the Department of Transportation to manufacture and erect such signs.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Other Fiscal Impact – Minimal to State and Local Government - However, to the extent that non-state funds are received from a local government, there will be a one-time, permissive increase in local government expenditures of approximately \$14,300.

Assumptions:

- Several different types of signs would be required according to the Department of Transportation.
- Two mainline signs @ \$3,625 each would be required at a total cost of \$7,250.
- Two ramp signs @ \$2,230 each would be required at a total cost of \$4,460.
- One US route trailblazer sign would be required at a cost of \$2,230.
- One state route trailblazer sign would be required at a cost of \$400.
