HB 1346 - SB 1647

March 12, 2009

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Adjutant General's office to notify the Governor if a member of the Tennessee National Guard dies in the line of duty. In any month in which one or more death notices are received, the Governor shall proclaim a day of mourning to honor such deceased member or members and shall order the flag to be flown at half-staff over the State Capitol during such day. The names of all guard members for whom a day of mourning is declared shall be recorded in the journals of the Senate and the House of Representatives.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumption:
