**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Authorizes the Attorney General, on behalf of the Division of Consumer Affairs in the Department of Commerce and Insurance, to file certain requests for information, requests for restraining orders, and orders of enforcement with the circuit or chancery court of Davidson County.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**Decrease State Expenditures – Not Significant**

Assumptions:

- Any cost can be accommodated within existing resources without an increased appropriation or reduced reversion.
- There would be a not significant decrease in travel for the Attorney General to file orders in all counties.
