FISCAL NOTE

HB 2290 - SB 2269

March 17, 2009

SUMMARY OF BILL: Expands civil service rights to include demotions. Deletes the requirement for the Commissioner of the Department of Human Resources to notify applicants of their rated score for position classification within 90 days. Requires the Commissioner to notify applicants of their score results within a reasonable time period. Requires that testing for position classification be open to all persons who possess the qualifications and pay the appropriate fees when required.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- The Department of Human Resources states that this bill will codify current practices related to the scoring of applications and testing and estimated no fiscal impact to the state.
- The added protection through civil service laws for demotions will not result in a significant increase in state expenditures.
