**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 2345 - SB 2202**

March 29, 2009

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Increases the fee for a lifetime senior citizen sportsman license from \$200 to \$250.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**MINIMAL**

Assumption:

- The provisions of the bill appear to raise the fee for a lifetime senior citizen sportsman license from \$200 to \$250 due to the change made by the bill in Tenn. Code Ann. § 70-2-201(h). However, the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA) was given the statutory authority to set license fees in 2005. Subsequently the price of the lifetime senior citizen sportsman license was raised from the \$200 amount stated in Tenn. Code Ann. § 70-2-201(h) to \$270. Therefore, according to TWRA, changing the dollar value in this section of code will not result in a change in the price of the lifetime senior citizen sportsman license.
