SUMMARY OF BILL: Subject to approval by a two-thirds vote of the legislative body, authorizes the General Sessions judge in Crockett County to sit by interchange with any circuit, criminal, or any other court of general jurisdiction.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

MINIMAL

Assumptions:

- According to Crockett County, authorizing judges to sit by interchange will not result in any increase or decrease in local expenditures.
- According to the Administrative Office of the Courts, this legislation will not result in any increase or decrease in state expenditures.
