SUMMARY OF BILL: Extends, from 60 to 90 days, the amount of time in which a parent who is relocating outside the state, or more than 100 miles from the other parent within the state, must notify the other parent of the relocation by registered or certified mail.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Increase State Revenue - Not Significant
Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant**

**Increase Local Revenue – Not Significant
Increase Local Expenditures – Not Significant**

Assumptions:

- The legislation does not change information included in the notice of relocation or the amount of time in which the other parent may file a petition in opposition to the move.
- Any impact to the number of cases in the court system will not be significant. Any increase to state and local expenditures and revenue associated with these court cases are estimated to be not significant.
