FISCAL NOTE

HB 2706 – SB 2714

January 21, 2010

SUMMARY OF BILL: Designates the segment of State Route 76 (South Main Street) from such route's intersection with U.S. Highway 64 in the city of Somerville to its intersection with State Route 195 at the three-way intersection in Fayette County as the *Captain Arthur Williamson Parkway* and directs the Department of Transportation (TDOT) to manufacture and erect suitable signs. Designating signs shall be erected only if non-state funds are paid to the TDOT to manufacture and erect such signs.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Other Fiscal Impact – Minimal to State and Local Government – However, to the extent that non-state funds are received from a local government, there will be a one-time, permissive increase in local government expenditures of \$325.

Assumption:

- The cost to manufacture and erect two (2) signs @ \$162.50 each is \$325.
