SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from 72 to 120 hours, the period a humane society must hold an abandoned animal prior to lawful destruction.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase Local Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- According to the Department of Agriculture, there will be no regulatory or fiscal impact on state government.
- This legislation is applicable to privately held humane societies registered with the state. Certain local governments make donations to humane societies but do not fund at 100 percent. Any increase to local expenditures is estimated to be not significant.
