HB 7013 – SB 7011
FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION
January 13, 2010

SUMMARY OF BILL: Removes the requirement that the Tennessee Higher Education Commission develop a master plan in accordance with the regulations of the state Publication Commission. Authorizes the Tennessee Board of Regents to set up agreements between community colleges and technology centers so that programs and courses offered at one entity may be physically taken at the other.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- Any increase in state expenditures to develop these agreements is estimated to be not significant.
- Setting up these agreements between community colleges and technology centers will not require a new state appropriation.
