SUMMARY OF BILL: Creates a joint committee to study the economic and regulatory impact of broadening the number and types of establishments involved with and related to the sale of wine and alcoholic beverages. The Committee will report its findings and recommendations to the 107th [sic] General Assembly by July 1, 2010, at which time the Committee will cease to exist.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$2,000/Each One-Day Meeting

Assumption:

- Travel and per diem expenses for six legislative members of \$1,952.64 per meeting (\$171 per diem plus \$154.44 mileage for each member).
