SUMMARY OF BILL: Designates the segment of U.S. Highway 41-A in Cheatham County from the intersection with Jackson Felts Road to Sycamore Creek Bridge as the *John 'Pat' Chandler Memorial Highway* and directs the Department of Transportation (TDOT) to erect suitable signs. Designating signs shall be erected only if the cost of the signs is paid to TDOT by Cheatham County within one year of the effective date of the resolution.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase Local Expenditures - \$325/One-Time/Permissive

Assumption:

- The cost to manufacture and erect two signs at \$162.50 each is \$325.
