SB 244 - HB 362

SUMMARY OF BILL: Eliminates the putative father registry and deletes all references to the registry.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Decrease State Expenditures - \$36,700

Decrease Federal Expenditures - \$12,300

Assumptions:

- Currently, the Department of Children's Services (DCS) has one position staffing the registry. Elimination of the registry will eliminate the need for the position resulting in a decrease of \$49,000.
- The \$49,000 includes state funds of \$36,700 and federal funds of \$12,300.
- The Office of Vital Records would no longer provide birth certificates to the registry resulting in a not significant decrease in expenditures.
