**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 379 - HB 1086**

February 16, 2009

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Eliminates current requirement on appointments to the Judicial Selection Commission by the Speaker of the Senate and Speaker of the House that three members come from a list supplied by the Tennessee Trial Lawyers Association, three members come from a list supplied by the District Attorneys General Conference, one member be a non-lawyer, and one lawyer member not nominated by a group. Requires instead that of the seven appointments by each Speaker, no more than three shall come from any grand division. Each Speaker shall appoint one non-lawyer, and jointly appoint one other non-lawyer. States a person on the first panel of nominees that is rejected by the Governor is not eligible to be on the second panel.
