SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Select Oversight Committee on Long-Term Care to review and evaluate outreach and eligibility efforts concerning the OPTIONS program for individuals not eligible for medical assistance. The Commissioner of Finance and Administration is required to report the quality of care and financial effects of the initiative to transition individuals out of nursing homes to the Select Oversight Committee on Long-Term Care, the Senate General Welfare, Health, and Human Resources Committee, and the House Health and Human Resources Committee.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumption:

- Any cost can be accommodated within existing resources without an increased appropriation or reduced reversion.
