SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Tennessee Board of Regents (TBR) and the University of Tennessee (UT) Board of Trustees to study the impact of the American history requirement on the articulation of credits between the two systems and make any necessary recommendations for change to facilitate articulation.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant
