**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 651 - HB 792**

March 19, 2009

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires licensed contract security companies to provide information to local law enforcement agencies relative to the armed and unarmed security guards who are providing services within 15 days of enactment of this bill or within 15 days of beginning service. Requires local law enforcement agencies to notify the Commissioner of Commerce and Insurance of any violation of this requirement. Requires the Commissioner to provide written notification of action to the law enforcement agency.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant**

**Increase Local Expenditures – Not Significant**

Assumptions:

- Any cost for investigating reports of violations by the Department of Commerce and Insurance can be accommodated within existing resources without an increased appropriation or reduced reversion.
- According to the County Technical Assistance Service (CTAS) and the Municipal Technical Advisory Service (MTAS), any increase in local expenditures for complying with the notification requirements is estimated to be not significant.
