**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 1067 - HB 1372**

March 6, 2009

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires the Department of Safety to provide, within reason, expedited driver license services for physically disabled, pregnant, or frail applicants. Requires the Department of Safety to post appropriate signage in service centers for the purpose of notifying such persons of the possibility for expedited services.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**Increase State Expenditures - \$2,600/One-Time**

Assumptions:

- According to the Department of Safety, departmental expenditures would increase as a result of creating and posting new signs at each of the 52 service centers.
- The cost per sign is estimated to be \$50 each.
- The one-time increase to state expenditures is estimated to be \$2,600 (52 x \$50 = \$2,600).
