FISCAL NOTE

SB 1080 - HB 1216

March 2, 2009

SUMMARY OF BILL: Expands the category of land surveyors to include certified engineers who have demonstrated competency in land surveying and performed land surveying duties prior to July 1, 1979. Exempts certified engineers from the educational requirements for certification.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Increase State Revenue - \$1,500/One-Time/FY09-10
\$1,400/Biennially/Beginning FY 11-12**

Assumptions:

- According to the Department of Commerce and Insurance, there could be an increase of approximately five additional registrants as a result of this bill for increased one-time revenue of \$1,500 (\$200 application fee + \$100 registration fee x 5 new applicants).
- Renewal fees for the additional five registrants equal \$1,400 (\$280 per licensee x 5 licensees).
- No impact on the Board of Architects and Engineers.
