SB 1753 - HB 1413

SUMMARY OF BILL: Deletes and replaces a portion of the definition for "Historic interpretive center" as such definition applies to the on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages. Current law includes language that states that the center is in a restored theater at least 50 years old and listed on the national register of historic places and that the center is leased and operated by a for-profit corporation or not-for-profit corporation. This language is replaced with language stating that the center is located in a historic area of town where structures listed on the national register of historic places are located and that the center operates as a not-for-profit corporation.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

MINIMAL

Assumption:

- The changes to the definition comply with the current location and operation of an entity already licensed. No additional businesses will be licensed as a result of these changes.
