FISCAL NOTE

SB 1989 - HB 1819

March 2, 2009

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases from 50 to 60 miles the radius within which certain farm equipment or machinery in excess of maximum width or height restrictions can be driven on roadways during daylight hours without a permit.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Decrease State Revenue – Not Significant/Highway Fund
Decrease State Expenditures – Not Significant/Highway Fund**

Assumptions:

- Special permits for driving such farm equipment or machinery are issued by the Department of Transportation (TDOT).
- Based on information received from TDOT, any decrease to state revenue that would be derived from issuing fewer permits or any decrease of state expenditures resulting from fewer permits being issued is considered to be not significant.
