SB 2050 - HB 1978

March 9, 2009

SUMMARY OF BILL: Creates the Local Government Electronic Technology Act of 2009, which encourages the use of technology and requires any local government implementing a new electronic technology associated with the disbursement of public funds, purchasing, the sale of government assets, or the collection of various taxes, fines, fees, or payments to file a plan with the Comptroller for comment.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase Local Expenditures – Not Significant/Permissive

Assumptions:

- Any increase in local expenditures to local governments who choose to implement new technology and are thus required to file a plan with the Comptroller is estimated to be not significant.
- This legislation may encourage local governments to update technology, which could result in additional savings. However, these savings cannot be quantified.
