**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 2108 - HB 2215**

March 16, 2009

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires the Health Services and Development Agency to report an analysis of the application for certificates of need made by hospitals and their disposition and identify any relevant difference between general acute care and specialty hospitals. The report shall be made on or before February 1, 2010, and every four years thereafter to the Senate General Welfare, Health, and Human Resources Committee and the House Health and Human Resources Committee.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant**

Assumptions:

- The Health Services and Development Agency will not incur any significant cost to collect, analyze, and report the required information.
- State departments, including the Departments of Health, Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities, and the Bureau of TennCare, will not incur a significant increase in expenditures to provide necessary data.
- Any cost can be accommodated within existing resources without an increased appropriation or reduced reversion.
