SUMMARY OF BILL: Removes the reporting requirements placed on the University of Tennessee's black fly suppression program. Currently, the University is required to report to the Departments of Agriculture and Environment and Conservation; the Senate Commerce, Labor, and Agriculture Committee; the Senate Environment, Conservation, and Tourism Committee; the House Agriculture Committee; and the House Conservation and Environment Committee.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Decrease State Expenditures – Not Significant

- Any decrease in state expenditures as a result of the removal of these reporting requirements is estimated to be not significant.
