SB 2682 - HB 2798

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes a county Election Commission to email a ballot to each member of the armed forces and each citizen temporarily outside the United States who is entitled to vote and who has submitted a valid application for a ballot.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase Local Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- This would bring Tennessee into compliance with the federal Military and Overseas Voter Empowerment Act (MOVE Act).
- According to the Coordinator of Elections, all counties are currently computerized.
- Any cost to county Election Commissions to develop a system to meet the requirements of the bill is estimated to be not significant.
