FISCAL NOTE

SB 2910 - HB 3026

February 12, 2010

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes human resource agencies and development districts to obtain government service plates for vans owned by such human resource agencies and development districts and used exclusively for such entities' activities.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Decrease State Revenue - \$2,200

Decrease Local Revenue - \$2,700

Assumptions:

- It is anticipated that most vans owned by human resource agencies and development districts have government service license plates.
- An estimated 100 vans that do not have government service plates would apply and receive such plates.
- The decrease in state revenue is estimated to be approximately \$2,150 based on a loss of \$21.50 for each of 100 vans that would receive a government license plate (100 vehicles x \$21.50).
- The decrease in local revenue is estimated to be approximately \$2,700 based on the loss of local wheel tax of \$27.00 for each of 100 vans that would receive a government license plate (100 vehicles x \$27.00).
