FISCAL NOTE

SB 3041 - HB 3151

February 23, 2010

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires an applicant for a driver license with two convictions of driving under the influence (DUI) in a period of five years to have an ignition interlock device installed for six months after the revocation period. Requires proof of installation and operation of the device prior to issuance of a driver license.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

MINIMAL

Assumption:

- According to the Department of Safety, there is no fiscal impact since the Department already requires an ignition interlock device for drivers with two convictions in five years and already requires the examiners to verify that the device has been installed prior to issuing a driver license.
