**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 3216 - HB 3455**

February 3, 2010

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires the Coordinator of Elections to develop and implement a framework of policies and procedures designed to preserve and protect the integrity and reliability of all voting machines and related equipment used in Tennessee during the 2010 regular November election. Requires by April 12, 2010, the Coordinator of Elections to submit a report to the Governor and members of the General Assembly and to appear before the State and Local Government Committees of the Senate and House of Representatives to describe such policies and provide a timeline for implementation.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant**
