**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 3638 - HB 3753**

February 11, 2010

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Urges public transportation buses to promote the existence of the Prevent Child Abuse Tennessee hotline. Requires the Department of Education to require local education agencies to distribute information on the hotline. Requires the Department of Human Services to require child care facilities to distribute information on the hotline.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant**

**Increase Local Expenditures – Exceeds \$10,000/Permissive**

Assumptions:

- According to the Departments of Education and Human Services, any increase in state expenditures is estimated to be not significant.
- Local governments that choose to promote the hotline on their buses will experience a permissive increase in expenditures estimated to exceed \$10,000.
