FISCAL NOTE

SB 3833 - HB 3818

February 24, 2010

SUMMARY OF BILL: Eliminates the time period of “twenty-four (24) hours” and replaces it with “one full business day” in which landfills must notify the Department of Environment and Conservation regarding waste not baled in accordance with a permit issued. Adds mailing and electronic addresses to the list of information required on the manifest of any waste that is transported. Increases from 30 to 40 years the time period that manifest records must be kept at any facility.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Increase Local Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- Any increase to local government expenditures resulting from a longer period of manual storage will be not significant.
- According to the Department of Environment and Conservation, there will be no fiscal impact on state government resulting from these requirements.
