SB 3856 - HB 3802

February 26, 2010

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes the Department of Finance and Administration to establish, develop, and manage an Internal Health Council consisting of the Commissioners of Finance and Administration, Children's Services, Correction, Health, Human Services, Education, and Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities, the Health Information Technology Coordinator, and the Deputy Commissioner of the Division of Intellectual Disabilities Services. The Council shall assist the state coordinator with implementing, coordinating, and integrating the health information technology infrastructure with the statewide health information exchange through the review and analysis of new information technology.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- All Council meetings will occur in Nashville.
- Since all the members of the Council are commissioners or directors, there will not be any additional compensation or travel reimbursement.
- Any cost to provide administrative support to the Council will not be significant and can be accommodated within existing resources without an increased appropriation or reduced reversion.
