FISCAL NOTE**

SB 3872 - HB 3829

February 16, 2010

SUMMARY OF BILL: Adds Hill Forest in Davidson County to the list of class II natural scientific areas. Increases from 200 to 250 acres the area of Carroll Cabin Barrens considered a class II natural scientific area. Increases from 3,950 to 6,530 acres the area of Frozen Head State Park considered a class II scenic recreational area. Adds 7,320 acres to the area of Frozen Head State Park classified as neither a class I nor class II area. Increases from 3,950 to 6,530 acres the area of Frozen Head State Natural Area considered a class II natural scientific area.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

On February 15, 2010, we issued a fiscal note for this bill indicating a fiscal impact of *Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant; Increase Local Expenditures – Not Significant*. An error was made in the bill summary stating an increase in the area of Frozen Head State Park considered a class I scenic recreational area. This change has no impact on the original fiscal impact.

Assumption:

- According to the Department of Environment and Conservation, there will be no cost associated with acquiring this land. Any costs to state government can be accommodated within existing resources without an increased appropriation or reduced reversion.
