AMEND Senate Bill No. 2580

House Bill No. 2725*

by adding the following new section immediately preceding the last section and by renumbering the subsequent section accordingly:

SECTION ____ Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 3, Chapter 1, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

3-1-123.

(a) The speaker of the house of representatives and the speaker of the senate, in consultation with the minority leaders in each house of the general assembly, shall develop and implement a system for drug testing the members of the general assembly. The system shall provide for the testing of a member of the general assembly in a manner consistent with the provisions for a drug free workplace under title 50, chapter 9, subject to the limitations of this section. The general assembly shall be deemed to be a covered employer for the purposes of title 50, chapter 9, involving compliance with the provisions of this section. The expenses of the system may be paid from applicable accounts of the general assembly for official purposes.

(b) Members of the general assembly elected on and after November 6, 2012 shall be tested in the same manner as an employee on the basis of a reasonable suspicion under § 50-9-106(a)(2). For any member of the general assembly who is subject to drug testing under this section, any refusal to submit to a drug test or any positive confirmed drug test shall be reported to the appropriate speaker for appropriate action. A member of the general assembly shall not be denied the seat to which the member was elected for a refusal to submit to a drug test or for a positive confirmed drug test, but the member may be subject to appropriate discipline by the appropriate house of the general
