HOUSE BILL 839

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4 and  
Title 71, relative to weatherization of homes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. The comptroller of the treasury is directed to study the process used for letting contracts for the delivery of weatherization services by the department of human services in order to make recommendations so as to increase the weatherization and energy conservation services and related home modifications delivered to elder persons and homeowners. The purpose of the study is to identify systemic impediments to the efficient delivery of such services that are not related to or in addition to issues of fraud identified in the comptroller's 2010 review of the program. The comptroller shall report the results of the study to the senate general welfare, health and human resources committee and the house health and human resources committee on or before February 1, 2012.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
